The Aerospace/ Astronomy intern will design and present public programs to middle school and community audiences. Goals for this position include:

- Designing and presenting planetarium programs, presentations, and activities for middle school and high school students (for use in the fixed and mobile domes and in programs at the LASC and in outreach)
- Reconfigure our current space exhibit, *Out of this World: A Space Adventure*, into a hands-on traveling program with teaching elements for elementary and middle school students

This is a paid position.

- Must be 18 and currently enrolled in a higher education program
- Must pass a simple background check (\$30 fee)
- Organized and able to work independently
- Good time management abilities
- Background in Aerospace/ Astronomy required
- Background in Education a plus
